

COVID-19 Student Code of Conduct Addendum

Effective: August 20, 2020

Student's Impacted

- 1. Student conduct and behaviour related to federal, provincial, municipal and institutional (Cape Breton University) policies and regulations as it relates to global pandemic of Covid-19.
- 2. Student's failing to follow any regulations put forth as per above noted authorities.

Process

- 1. Violations to the regulations will be reviewed through the Student Affairs Office.
- 2. Decisions will be vetted through the President's Office and will not be appealable.

Sanctions

- 1. Sanctions may be as outlined in the Code of Student Conduct for Non-Academic Infractions found on the CBU Campus Safety website.
- 2. Sanctions may be imposed in addition to other fines issued by government.
- 3. Sanctions may include financial penalty placed on student account, holds on student account, and up to deregistration for failure to comply with regulations.
