- Verify that laundry requests are completed for each department as needed.

- Operate steam press machines

- Set aside, report, and maintain inventory on all damaged or marked linens

- Maintain proper usage of cleaning supplies and equipment
- Follow departmental policies, procedures, and service standards
- Comply with proper security, fire regulation, and all health and safety policies
- Complete other duties as assigned by management
