<b>Prospective Transfers</b>	<p>CBU has an agreement with many colleges which results in transfer credit being given to specified Engineering Technology Diploma graduates, such that as few as 36 credits from CBU would be required to complete the BET Degree program.</p> <p>Prospective students are encouraged to contact their college for information on the agreement with CBU or to contact CBU directly. Where no agreement exists, individual consideration will be given to possible transfer credits. In any case, however, residency requirements must still be met.</p> <p><b>Electives:</b> Selection of all electives must be done through prior consultation with a faculty advisor from the program.</p>																																	

	<p><b>Residence requirements:</b> Graduation with the degree (or diploma) normally requires that the student take a minimum of 50% of the program's required courses from CBU. CBU distance courses can be included to meet the residency requirements. Some joint programs, such as the articulation agreements previously noted in the Transfer Credit section, may allow special circumstances which differ from this minimum.</p> <p><b>Graduation requirement:</b> For this three year program, a minimum of all courses in the program (or approved equivalent) must be completed to be eligible for graduation.</p>
<b>How To Apply</b>	<p>Students holding a completed diploma in any of the above agreements can apply to Cape Breton University online at <a href="http://www.cbu.ca/apply">www.cbu.ca/apply</a>. At the time of application, students will choose the <i>post-diploma</i> option of the degree and have all official transcripts forwarded to CBU. Once admitted into the program, students can meet with an academic advisor to help select the courses to complete their Bachelor of Engineering Technology degree.</p> <p>Students interested in applying for the Bachelor of Technology (Emergency Management) can apply online at <a href="http://www.cbu.ca/apply">www.cbu.ca/apply</a>. All official transcripts are to be forwarded to Cape Breton University along with a Statement of Interest, Cover letter and Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV).</p>

<b>Program Description</b>	<p>This articulation agreement will allow qualified Algonquin College students to get advanced standing and transfer credits at CBU. Students who successfully complete the Diploma in <b>Business Administration</b> from Algonquin College may receive up to 60 credits towards CBU's Bachelor of Business Administration.</p> <p>Transfer credits will be awarded for courses completed with a minimum grade of 63%.
