How To Apply	<p>Students holding a completed diploma in any of the above agreements can apply to Cape Breton University online at www.cbu.ca/apply. At the time of application, students will choose the Articulation Agreement option and have all official transcripts forwarded to CBU. Once admitted into the program, students can then apply for their transfer credits by submitting a Transfer Credit Assessment form found at http://www.cbu.ca/sites/cbu.ca/files/pdfs/transfer-credit-assessment-application.pdf. Keep in mind that every assessment is evaluated by the Registrar's Office on a case-by-case basis and can take up to 2-8 weeks to complete.</p>
