Program Description	This articulation agreement will allow qualified graduates of CNA diploma programs to enter CBU's Bachelor of Engineering Technology programs with advanced standing.																																																						
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Prospective Transfers	<p>CBU has an agreement with many colleges which results in transfer credit being given to specified Engineering Technology Diploma graduates, such that as few as 36 credits from CBU would be required to complete the BET Degree program.</p> <p>Prospective students are encouraged to contact their college for information on the agreement with CBU or to contact CBU directly. Where no agreement exists, individual consideration will be given to possible transfer credits. In any case, however, residency requirements must still be met.</p> <p>Electives: Selection of all electives must be done through prior consultation with a faculty advisor from the program.</p> <p>Residence requirements: Graduation with the degree (or diploma) normally requires that the student take a minimum of 50% of the program's required courses from CBU. CBU distance courses can be included to meet the residency requirements. Some joint programs, such as the articulation agreements previously noted in the Transfer Credit section, may allow special circumstances which differ from this minimum.</p> <p>Graduation requirement: For this three year program, a minimum of all courses in the program (or approved equivalent) must be completed to be eligible for graduation.</p>

At the time of application, students will choose the <i>post-diploma</i> option of the degree and have all official transcripts forwarded to CBU. Program Description	<p>This articulation agreement will allow qualified graduates of CNA diploma programs to enter CBU's Bachelor of Business Administration programs with advanced standing.</p> <p>The CBU Bachelor of Business Administration degree program requires the completion of a minimum of 60 to 93 credits of course work after graduation from a closely-linked diploma program as outline above. This normally requires a minimum of four to seven semesters of full time study to complete. Transfer credits will be awarded for courses completed with a minimum grade of 65%. Students must meet CBU's entrance criteria and have obtained the CNA's minimum passing grade in all courses to be accepted for advanced standing and direct entry to CBU's BBA. Specific course to course equivalency tables for each CNA program are provided in the Appendix A.</p>

Prospective Transfers	<p>Admissions Criteria</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Individuals seeking admission to CBU's BBA programs under this Articulation Agreement must have completed an appropriately matched CNA program with a minimum overall program grade point average of 65 percent. The entry Diploma or Certificate must have been awarded to the applicant by CNA, and a formal academic record verifying this event must have been officially transmitted to CBU before the student commences a Degree program at CBU. Students cannot transfer more than 50% of the total number of credits required for the completion of the program to which they are admitted. Of those credits transferred in, students must have completed a minimum of 50% at CNA or CNA-Q. If a student has been awarded transfer credits at CNA or CNA-Q, supporting official transcripts must be provided as part of the application for those to be recognised. Admission Regulations require that students provide official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions which they have attended. Application for transfer credits for courses from a third party institution will be considered on a course by course basis for those cases in which the number of transfer credits awarded does not add up to 50% of the total number of credits required for the program. BBA students admitted via this articulation agreement must complete the total number of credits of course work conveyed in this document for their selected BBA discipline option to receive this Degree. Further, all of these course credits must be taken through CBU. Language Proficiency: English is the primary language of instruction at CBU. It is essential that all students have an adequate knowledge in the areas of reading, writing, listening and speaking in the English language in order for them to be successful in their studies. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that their English is at a level of accomplishment necessary for their particular programs and specific requirements. Applicants whose first language is not English must provide documentation to show that CBU's English language proficiency requirements have been met.
