<b>Program Description</b>	This articulation agreement will allow qualified students of IIUC's program to enter CBU's Bachelor of Arts program with advanced standing.
<b>Program Details</b>	CBU and IIUC agree to cooperate with the purpose of offering degree completion options to the students of four-year Bachelor of Arts in English Language and Literature (ELL) program. Students completing the first two year of the ELL program from IIUC may apply for admission to the Bachelor of Arts (BA) at CBU. The BA is offered as a three (3)-year general or four (4) -year Major/Honors program at CBU. IIUC ELL transfer students will receive up to a maximum of 45 transfer credits toward the three-year BA program and up to a maximum of 60 transfer credits toward the four-year BA program. Specific course-to-course equivalency is outlined in Appendix A. Transfer credits will be awarded for courses completed with a minimum grade of 60%. Students must meet CBU's entrance criteria and have obtained a cumulative GPA of 60% or greater in all courses to be accepted for advanced standing and direct entry to CBU's BA.
<b>How To Apply</b>	Students holding a completed diploma in any of the above agreements can apply to Cape Breton University online at <a href="http://www.cbu.ca/come-to-cbu/apply-now/#apply">http://www.cbu.ca/come-to-cbu/apply-now/#apply</a> and choose <b>articulation agreement</b> under Student Status section. At the time of application, students must arrange to have all official transcripts forwarded to CBU for admission. Once admitted into the program, students can then apply for their transfer credits by submitting a Transfer Credit Assessment form found at <a href="http://www.cbu.ca/wp-content/uploads/meta_upload/transfer-credit-assessment-application.pdf">http://www.cbu.ca/wp-content/uploads/meta_upload/transfer-credit-assessment-application.pdf</a> .
