<p>Prospective transfers</p>	<p>Prospective students are encouraged to contact their college for information on the agreement with CBU or to contact CBU directly. Where no agreement exists, individual consideration will be given for possible transfer credits. In any case, however, residency requirements must still be met.</p> <p>An overall average of 60 percent is required for all students for admission to CBU degree programs, including those applying to most CBU credit programs, based on their high school performance. Additional requirements may apply to specific programs details are found at www.cbu.ca. If space permits, CBU will accept all candidates who can verify that they have met the minimum entry requirements established by CBU for the program in which they wish to enroll. Please note, the Bachelor of Science in Nursing, and the Bachelor of Education degree programs have limited enrolment.</p> <p>RESIDENCY AND DISTANCE COURSES: A number of CBU courses are available by distance (partially on or online), including some of the required courses for the Bachelor of Hospitality and Tourism Management degree program and may in some instances, be the only offering of that particular program that year. CBU distance courses can be used to fulfill the credit residency requirement.</p> <p>PRIOR LEARNING ASSESSMENT (PLA) CREDITS: Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) credits will not be granted for any required CBU credits indicated in this Articulation Agreement.</p> <p>Students who graduate with a SCBT Hospitality and Tourism diploma will be admissible to the BHTM program using their SCBT diploma as the basis for admission.</p>
<p>How To Apply</p>	<p>Students holding a completed diploma in the above agreement can apply to Cape Breton University online at www.cbu.ca/apply. At the time of application, students will choose the Articulation Agreement and have all official transcripts forwarded to CBU.</p> <p>Once admitted into the program, students can meet with an academic advisor to help select courses to complete the Bachelor of Hospitality and Tourism Management degree.</p>
