The following are approved for a TC 6 with 30 graduate credit hours:

MASTER OF EDUCATION IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

This 30 credit hour graduate degree is designed to facilitate the educational use of information technology in a wide variety of settings. The program is of interest to educators at all levels, including K-12 teachers, school administrators, post-secondary instructors, and individuals in business and industry. The M. Ed. (I.T.) encompasses computer, communications, networking and multi-media applications.

This degree is co-operatively offered and conferred by Memorial University. Both thesis and comprehensive course routes are available.

GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION: TECHNOLOGY

The 30 credit hour online graduate level Diploma in Educational Technology is designed to improve the technological skills of classroom teachers and to provide an in-depth exploration of the integration of technology across the curriculum. It is appropriate for teachers of all subject areas.

GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION: COUNSELLING

The 30 credit hour online graduate level Diploma in Education (Counseling) enhances the counseling skills of K-12 teachers in a variety of teaching and specialist positions. Courses and topics in counseling theory, differentiated instructional issues, individual and career counselling, mental health, diversity and culture, testing and a supervised practicum. The diploma has proven beneficial to all teachers as they navigate through the needs of their complex classes.

The following is approved for a TC 6 with 36 graduate credit hours:

GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION CURRICULUM

The 30 credit hour online graduate level Diploma in Education (Curriculum) is intended for learners who wish to pursue a deeper understanding of curriculum development and effective UDL implementation in their diverse classrooms. Beginning with the meaning and purpose of curriculum, students complete the program by developing a model curriculum with integrated formative and summative assessments that may be used in his or her differentiated classroom.

*While this program is 30 credit hours, we will provide two electives of your choice from any of our other Diploma programs to enable NB teachers to receive the additional credit hours needed in the non-teachable area.
