- SET UP YOUR STUDENT ONLINE ACCESS** - You must set up your Cape Breton University (CBU) Student Online Account. The Student Online Account is your portal to CBU where you can view your financial account, add/drop classes and more. To register visit: mysis.cbu.ca

- APPLY FOR A TRANSFER CREDIT ASSESSMENT** - If you've attended a previous post-secondary institution, you may be eligible to apply for transfer credits. Complete the Transfer Credit Application www.cbu.ca/transfer
Note: only documents submitted with your admission application will be reviewed.

- SECURE ACCOMMODATIONS** - You must secure housing before arriving in Canada. For on-campus housing (CBU residence housing) visit www.cbu.ca/residence. For off-campus housing visit www.cbu.ca/housing.

- BOOK ACADEMIC ADVISING AND REGISTER FOR CLASSES** - You must be registered for classes by **December 20, 2019**. If you are not registered for classes by **December 20, 2019** your Admission will be deferred until **May, 2020**. To register for classes, visit: www.cbu.ca/advising.
