Prospective Transfers	<p>Admissions Criteria</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Individuals seeking admission to CBU's BHTM program under this Articulation Agreement must have completed the first two years of an appropriately matched EC program with a minimum overall program grade point average of 60 percent. 2. A formal academic record verifying completion of an appropriately matched first two-year Hospitality Management program must have been officially transmitted to CBU before the student commences a Degree program at CBU. 3. Students cannot transfer more than 50% of the total number of credits required for the completion of the program to which they are admitted. Of those credits transferred in, students must have completed a minimum of 50% at the EC. If a student has been awarded transfer credits at the EC, supporting official transcripts must be provided as part of the application for those to be recognized. Admission Regulations require that students provide official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions which they have

Application for transfer credits for courses from a third-party institution will be considered on a course by course basis for those cases in which the number of transfer credits awarded does not add up to 50% of the total number of credits required for the program.</p> <p>4. Language Proficiency: English is the primary language of instruction at Cape Breton University. It is essential that all students have adequate knowledge in the areas of reading, writing, listening and speaking in the English language in order for them to be successful in their studies. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that their English is at a level of accomplishment necessary for their particular programs and specific requirements. Applicants whose first language is not English must provide documentation to show that CBU's English language proficiency requirements have been met.</p>
