

Jniversity Post-Baccalaureate Diploma in Health Care Management – Diploma Worksheet (4 Options)

May Intake Course Planning -- OPTION 1

- You must achieve a minimum of 60% in all required courses.
- To be eligible for an internship you must have an overall average of 70% (of courses taken in the diploma program).
- Prerequisite: The prerequisite course must be successfully completed <u>before</u> you are eligible to enroll in the course.
- It is very important that you follow the course planning outline below. Taking courses out of the planned order may result in failure to meet prerequisites for future courses and could result in a delay in program completion.
- You must earn 39 credits to complete the diploma. Successful completion of the 11 required courses will earn you 33 credits. The
 additional 6 credits will be earned upon successful completion of either the Internship (6 credits) or the Capstone Project (6 credits).
