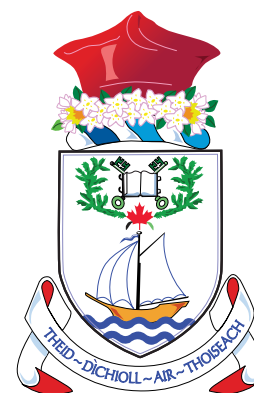

**Convocation** The ceremonial gathering of an assembly for the conferral of degrees, diplomas and certificates.

**Chancellor** The titular head of the University and the presiding officer of convocation. As the ceremonial head of the University, the Chancellor confers all degrees, diplomas and certificates on behalf of the University.

# Mr. Jack Graham

Cape Breton University is delighted to honour an outstanding, well-respected individual who has seen international recognition for both his work in the law profession and dedication to the world of professional tennis, Mr. Jack Graham.

Jack is a senior partner in Halifax at McInnes Cooper and practices labour and employment law throughout Atlantic Canada. He has extensive experience in all areas of employment law, including employment litigation, labour arbitration, collective bargaining, labour relations, human rights and workers' compensation.

He has been recognized by Best Lawyers<sup>TM</sup> in Canada and Lexpert as a leading labour and employment Law Practitioner since 2006. In both 2019 and 2020, Jack was named Labour and Employment Law "Lawyer of the Year" in Halifax Best Lawyers<sup>®</sup> and was also repeatedly recommended in the Canadian Legal Lexpert<sup>®</sup> Directory. He has also been ranked in the Chambers Canada 2023 Legal Rankings for Employment & Labour.

He is known for having outstanding strategic abilities and has represented clients in some of the most complex public and private sector labour matters in Atlantic Canada for many years.

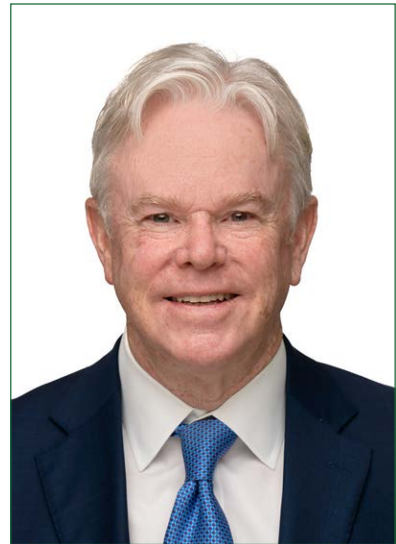
Jack is a Past President of the Canadian Association of Counsel to Employers, and in 2017, he received the Heenan-Ross Award for outstanding contributions to CACE.

Outside of the profession of law, Jack has been involved with the sport of tennis for many years. He is a Past Chair of the Board of Tennis Canada. Jack also serves on the Board of the International Tennis Federation (ITF).

He has chaired the ITF Constitutional Committee, which is responsible for governance and legal issues at the ITF, for the past 12 years.

Jack is also the Founder and Chair of the Board of the Atlantic Tennis Center. In 2020, Jack was chosen to be inducted into the Tennis Canada Hall of Fame as a Builder. In 2012 and 2013, Jack's contributions to tennis were also recognized by his induction into the Nova Scotia Sport Hall of Fame and by receiving the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal for outstanding contributions to Canadian sport from the Canadian Olympic Committee.

Today, Cape Breton University confers the degree Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*, on a leader who has excelled within two vastly different fields, law and professional tennis, yet has so done with dedication, professionalism and tenacity for both, Mr. Jack Graham.

# Mr. Stephen Muise

Cape Breton University is delighted to honour and recognize a man who has spent his career educating Cape Breton youth, sharing his love of music, culture and the arts and who has seen a global spotlight with the world-renowned Men of the Deeps, Mr. Stephen Muise.

Stephen Muise has been a full-time educator for more than 25 years and holds degrees in both music and education with a Master's in Education Administration (BMus, BEd and M.Ed). In January 2017, Stephen accepted the role of Conductor for the world-famous Men of the Deeps, North America's only coal miners' chorus.

Stephen strives to connect the world of professional entertainment to his environment of learning, providing unlikely opportunities for students by pairing them with performing artists. In recognition of his many collaborations, in December 2022, Stephen was the recipient of the Canadian Band Association Community Builders Award, a national honour for his community work with students and professional musicians.

Stephen is co-owner of Olive Street Entertainment (OSE), an entertainment production company, with his spouse and business partner, Jenn Sheppard. The company produces various large-scale events, fundraisers and productions for businesses. OSE also runs the daily business operations and logistics for the Men of the Deeps, The Island Girls, High Society and the Privateers.

In 2023, Stephen was nominated for Outstanding Musical Direction at the 2023 Merritt Awards for his work on *Dear Rita*, a musical tribute to the life of Rita MacNeil. Stephen's involvement in the music industry has allowed him to work with artists such as Rita MacNeil, The Rankin Family, The Island Girls, The Barra MacNeils, Bruce Guthro, Matt Andersen, Gordie Sampson, Sam Moon, Fred Lavery, Matt Minglewood and more.

During the COVID pandemic, Stephen, Jenn and their daughter, Jordyn, created an online event called Garbage Night Sessions, with live music and special guests. The trio managed to raise more than \$100,000 for various community endeavours and were able to purchase and deliver 48 iPads to seniors who were in long-term care facilities across the Island.

Today, Cape Breton University confers the degree Doctor of Letters, *honoris causa*, on an educator and entertainer whose love of music and arts is the guiding principle of his work and who ensures he leaves a legacy with every project he undertakes, Mr. Stephen Muise.

# Ms. Andrea Rosen

Cape Breton University is delighted to honour and recognize an accomplished executive leader in the Canadian Financial and Banking Sector and a trailblazer for equality and equity in the business world, Ms. Andrea Rosen.

Andrea earned her MBA from the Schulich School of Business at York University and earned her law degree from Osgoode Hall Law School as a participant in the joint MBA/LL.B program. After graduation, she entered the male-dominated world of finance and banking – often as one of the only women in the room. She rose through the ranks of both CIBC Wood Gundy and TD and was Vice Chair of TD Bank Financial Group and President of TD Canada Trust from 2002 to 2005.

Not only was Andrea a newcomer to Canada from the United States, she was often one of the very few female vice-chairs in the domestic banking industry in Canada. Previously, she was Executive Vice President of TD Commercial Banking and Vice Chair of TD Securities. Andrea also served as Vice President of Varity Corporation from 1991 to 1994. Between 1981 and 1990, she held a variety of roles at Wood Gundy Inc. (later CIBC Wood Gundy), eventually becoming Vice President and Director, the first female to be appointed as a partner in the firm.

In addition to being a long-serving Director at Nova Scotia based Emera Inc., she is also a Director of Manulife Financial Corporation.

Andrea is also a Director on the Boards of Ceridian HCM Holding Inc., Element Fleet Management Corp., and the Institute of Corporate Directors. She is a former Director of the Alberta Investment Management Corporation (AIMCo) and of Hiscox Ltd.

Her accomplishments are many, and her connections to Cape Breton are deep through her father-in-law, as well as her 16 years of working with Emera in the province.

Andrea is a proud wife and the mother of two young women. Andrea hopes that through her work and dedication in advocating for women in the workforce, she has inspired her daughters to seek more and blaze their own trails.

Today, Cape Breton University confers the degree Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*, on a role model for all aspiring leaders, especially women, for her ongoing passionate support for diversity, advocacy and inclusion at every organization she is involved with, Ms. Andrea Rosen.

Dr. Philip Michael Smith was born and raised in Halifax, Nova Scotia. He is one of four siblings born to Lorraine and Philip Smith, both of Halifax. Dr. Smith is a graduate of Dalhousie University with a Bachelor of Science in Biochemistry and a Doctor of Medicine. This was followed by a residency in General Surgery.

Dr. Smith is passionate about mentoring and teaching medical students and helping colleagues. He has been an examiner of general surgical residents for the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada for 11 years. He is a remarkably effective recruiter of surgeons to the province and is well-respected by his colleagues and patients.

He has served on a variety of boards in executive capacities, including President of Nova Scotia General Surgeons for two terms; Executive Board of the Canadian Association of General Surgeons for two terms; Section Chair, Board of Directors for Doctors Nova Scotia; and Rural Specialist, Board of Directors with Doctors Nova Scotia. Dr. Smith is a lifelong learner, teacher, mentor and role model.

In 1990, he married his wife, a fellow physician, who was born and raised in Cape Breton, and they settled here in 1991 when Phil's surgical career began. With an absolute love for Cape Breton from the outset, the people, the culture and the land, Phil and his family quickly became active members of the community.

He is dedicated to his community and has helped numerous organizations he believes in to expand and grow. He was the lead of the fundraising committee for the capital refurbishment of the Northern Yacht Club Junior Sail Program and the development of their Sail Able Program, a program for limited-ability sailors.

He also co-chaired the \$5.5 million Cape Breton Cares Campaign for the development of the radiation wing of the CB Regional Cancer Centre.

## Cape Breton University Mace, Chain of Office and Chairs

The Mace, given by Mr. and Mrs. Irving Schwartz in memory of Mrs. Rose Schwartz, was designed and created by Cape Breton's own jeweller and craftsman, Darryl MacLeod. The shaft of the Mace is formed by a portion of an oak window from Moxham's Castle. The top of the ornate crown is adorned with four diamonds donated by Dr. Robert Morgan in memory of his wife, Barbara, who died in 1993.

The President's Chain of Office, also designed and created by Mr. MacLeod, speaks boldly of Cape Breton University and Cape Breton. The Chain was commissioned in honour of Cape Breton University's twentieth anniversary and was donated by the partners and staff of Deloitte & Touche in honour of Mr. James W. Miller, former managing partner.

Silver thistles and gold fiddles join the Chain. The Chain also has a silver fleur de lis, a replica of a coin from the "Chameau" treasure, and a silver medallion of the Cross and Crescent of the Mi'kmaw flag. CBU's Coat of Arms shares the focal point with the Great Seal of Cape Breton. The Chain is designed to represent our ties with the French and Mi'kmaw cultures, as well as our strong Celtic ties with the Scottish, Irish and Breton settlers.

Cape Breton's best known furniture maker, Leo MacNeil, crafted two chairs for our Institution. The larger of the two chairs is used by the Chancellor during convocation ceremonies. The back of the chair has the Cape Breton University Coat of Arms hand engraved and painted. The second chair is used by the President. Both chairs have been constructed from Cape Breton oak, with green velvet seats to complement the University's colours and the green of Cape Breton.
