

Entry Guidelines for: ProletariArt 2023 The People's Art Exhibit

All members of the Cape Breton Community are invited to submit artwork for inclusion in **ProletariART 2023: The People's Art Exhibit** held at the CBU Art Gallery from **September 15, 2023 – February 16, 2024**.

ProletariART is a non-juried exhibition. All artwork submitted within the guidelines below will be accepted and displayed subject to available gallery space. Exhibitors are encouraged to submit their artwork early during the drop-off period to avoid disappointment.

Submissions can be dropped off at the CBU Art Gallery between Monday July 31 – Friday August 18, 2023 (Mondays – Fridays only), 10:00 am – 4:00 pm. The final date for submissions to the exhibition will be Friday August 18, 2023 4:00 pm.

- Works may be submitted by any member of the CBU community or general public.
- Any works submitted to ProletariART 2019 will be automatically accepted for exhibition with the exception of offensive material.
- There is no submission fee.
- Works may be presented in any media that is safe to exhibit (e.g. painting, drawing, photography, performance, digital media, video, sculpture).
- Each participant may contribute **one work of art** for the exhibition.
- The CBU Art Gallery will be responsible for all curatorial and installation decisions for the exhibition.
- Works will be on display for the duration of the exhibition and may not be removed from the gallery until Monday February 19, 2024 (10:00 – 4:00 pm). No work can be withdrawn or swapped once submitted.
- As a public gallery, Cape Breton University Art Gallery does not facilitate the sale or hire of artwork. Purchase enquiries will be directed to the artist or designated agent.
- Works must be submitted in 'ready to exhibit' condition (framed or ready to display in a safe
 and professional manner in a public gallery with required hardware affixed). Professional
 framing is not necessary, but works must be presentable (i.e. do not submit a drawing on loose
 paper). Hanging wire is preferred for work that is framed (as opposed to alligator hooks or dhooks).
- Works that are not ready to exhibit or deemed not presentable will not be accepted.
- Participants are responsible for picking up their own work after the exhibition ends and the Gallery is not responsible for storing any work not picked up by Friday February 19, 2023, 4:00 pm.
- Each submission <u>must</u> be supplemented by a **completed submission form**. **Works will not be** accepted without this form.
- For insurance purposes each submission must be assigned a \$ value (with a min. value of \$1).
