## Marketing Major

- Plus 15 credits from: MRKT 2303, 3124, 3304, 3307, 3309, 4304, 4305, 4306, 4307, 4309, 4311, 4313, 4314, 4605, HATM 3508
- Additional requirements: minimum 60% in above courses, minimum 65% average in years 3 and 4 and 12 credits must be at the 400 level

## Supply Chain Management Major
