



EXCHANGE PROGRAM

The Canadian International College (CIC) and Cape Breton University (CBU) implemented a Student Exchange Agreement to enhance the educational and cross-cultural experience of students from both institutions.

The period of exchange is for one academic year or one academic term. Exchange to CBU can only occur in the Fall (September) term.

ELIGIBILITY TO EXCHANGE TO CBU

- Completed at least one year at CIC.
- Minimum overall average of 75% over the previous two semesters with no failures.
- Must be registered as a full-time student in your last two terms prior to the Fall term at CBU.
- Must provide proof of English Language Proficiency.

- To be at least 19 years old.

A maximum of five students can exchange at CBU each academic year. CIC students enrolled in the student Exchange program will not be eligible for CBU Academic Scholarship.
